# **Board Paper Reference – GLA48/17– Survey Update**

# 1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 To update the Board on the GLA Survey of Licence Holders.

#### 2. Recommendation

- 2.1 The Board is invited to note this paper.
- 2.2 The Board is invited to comment on the proposed questions.
- 2.3 The GLA will report to the Board the outcomes of the pulse survey at the April Board Meeting.

#### **Reasons for Recommendations**

- 3.1 The GLA has previously run an annual satisfaction survey for licence holders. The purpose of this survey is to explore how licence holders feel about the GLA. The Licensing team uses the results of the survey to inform its stakeholder engagement activity and to make improvements to its processes.
- 3.2 In August 2015, in line with Government policy, the GLA decided to change its approach to surveys. The Licensing team has moved away from an annual survey and instead sends out a short survey when licensing activity occurs e.g. renewal or application. The GLA hoped that this would increase the number of licence holders who participated in the survey.
- 3.3 The GLA has had a low response rate to its online surveys (7 responses to date) and therefore considers it would be useful to vary its approach but retaining a shorter survey. The GLA anticipates that it may be able to run the pulse survey at the GLA conference to encourage participation.

## 4. Summary of Key Points

- 4.1 Due to the low response rate to its surveys, the GLA will be running a pulse survey to ascertain overall satisfaction of licence holders and applicants.
- 4.2 The questions that could be covered in the survey are at Appendix A. The GLA anticipates that it may ask only a small selection of the questions outlined here, dependent on time available at the conference.
