Subject: Budgets specifically for anti-trafficking activities

Question(s):

1. Budgets/funding or any other resources directly allocated by the Authority towards anti-trafficking activities and/or activities to combat 'modern slavery' in 2021 (6 April 2021 – 5 April 2022) and 2022 (6 April 2022 – 5 April 2023) financial years (for example, dedicated projects, anti-trafficking operations, members of staff, information campaigns etc.) and what these activities are.
2. If available, a copy of the organisational strategy or any other document which sets out what actions are to be taken by the Authority to combat trafficking in human beings and/or 'modern slavery' as mandated by the UK Modern Slavery Act (2015).

Response:
