<u>BOARD PAPER REFERENCE – GLA 31/10.2 – Appointment of Board</u> Members

Issue

- 1. There is an immediate need to hold a recruitment exercise to fill six vacancies on the Gangmasters Licensing Authority (GLA) Board.
- 2. It would be desirable, to ensure regular renewal of expertise, knowledge and experience, to organise future appointments on a staggered basis so as to avoid the current situation where the majority of GLA Board Members' terms end at the same time (31 March 2012).
- 3. Defra officials will be consulting their ministers shortly about a proposal which will involve:
 - 3.1. interviews by a Defra chaired Panel, on which I will sit as a 2nd member together with a 3rd independent member appointed by the Commissioner for Public Appointments, for the vacant positions for the following representative bodies: NFU England, UNITE, Sea Fish Industry Authority, Food and Drink Federation, Local Government Regulation and the British Retail Consortium.
 - 3.2. the extension of the terms of existing members by 2 or 3 years, depending on the initial date of appointment. This would follow on from a one to one appraisal process conducted by myself. (Note: It is recommended good practice for all public bodies to have an annual appraisal process for Board Members.)

Recommendations
