BOARD PAPER REFERENCE - GLA 16/8.1 - GLA Annual Review 2007

<u>Issue</u>

1. To present to the Board a draft of the GLA first year review, conducted by the University of Sheffield. This paper is accompanied by a presentation by the researchers.

Recommendation

2. The Board is invited to note the review and forward any comments on the draft to the researchers by 2 November 2007. The Board is also asked to note the process for responding to the report.

Background

- 3. The Gangmasters (Licensing) Act 2004 requires the GLA to keep under review the activities of labour providers. A baseline report assessing the nature of the industry as licensing commenced was published August. The draft report at annex A (Executive Summary) and B (Full Report) assesses the impact of the GLA during the first year of operations. The report will be publishing following consideration of any comments raised by the Board.
- 4. The report makes a series of recommendations to the Authority (see chapter 8). A paper proposing responses to the recommendations will be presented to the January 2008 Board meeting.
- 5. Further annual reviews are planned to be published in Autumn 2008 and 2009.
