Decision and Summary Statement of Reasons of the Appointed Person, in relation to the above matter:

Decision

The Appeal is dismissed. This Decision is to take effect immediately.

Summary Statement of Reasons

1. The Appellant appeals Ref No: 105/E/RV lodged on 30 June 2010 against Revocation of the Appellant's Licence by the GLA to take effect on 2 June 2010.
2. The ground of revocation was that the Appellant is not a fit and proper person to hold a Licence.
3. The Appeals Secretariat have written to the Principal Authority, Mr Harbron and the GLA's application for the Appeal to be struck out has been sent to the Appellant. No response to either has been received.
4. The Companies Register shows the Appellant as being in liquidation. Accordingly, the Appellant is not in a position to trade as a Gangmaster. No Liquidator has approached the GLA or the Appeals Secretariate.
5. I bear in mind the Overriding Objective in Regulation 2 of the Gangmasters (Appeals) Regulations 2006
6. No request for an Oral Hearing has been made. Accordingly, I determine this Appeal without an oral hearing.
7. In these circumstances I find that the Appeal has been abandoned by the Appellant and is therefore dismissed.
