Subject: Gangmaster convictions and revocations in Norfolk in past three years	
Question(s) asked: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• For each of the past three years, can you tell how many people have been convicted of operating as an unlicensed gangmaster in Norfolk. If you are able to give more detail, can you break it down by name of person convicted, how long they were sentenced for, where in Norfolk they were from and what sector they worked in.• For each of the past three years, can you tell me how many gangmasters have lost their licence in connection with employing illegal migrant workers/exploiting their workers. If you are able to provide more detail, can you break it down by name of person, name of company, why they lost their licence, where in Norfolk they were from and what sector they worked in.	
Response(s) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In the past three years only one Norfolk gangmaster has been convicted of operating as a gangmaster without a licence. His name is Audrius Morkunas. Full details of his case are available here.• Five companies based in Norfolk have had licences revoked by the GLA in the past three years. None was found to have been employing illegal migrant workers.
