

Parliamentary Question – Publishing revocation results

Question: To ask the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs if he will make it the policy of the Gangmasters Licensing Authority (GLA) to publish revocations without immediate effect on the GLA online register?

Response: The GLA is considering changes to its public register following the outcome of the Red Tape Challenge review. The GLA's Board has had an initial discussion of the pros and cons of publishing information on licenses which have been revoked without immediate effect and that are open to appeal. It will consider the matter further at a future meeting, but at present there are no firm proposals to change the current practice.
