Question:

To ask the Secretary of State for the Home Department, how much compensation has been received by victims of trafficking identified by the Gangmasters' Licensing Authority in each year since 2014.

Response:

During the financial years 2014/15 to 2017/18, no prosecutions arising from investigations by the Gangmasters and Labour Abuse Authority resulted in compensation orders for victims of trafficking identified by the Authority.
