



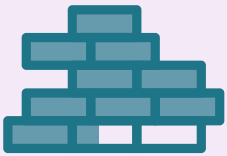
Construction protocol survey results



54% of respondents said the **GLAA bulletin** was the most useful resource.



have introduced **training and awareness campaigns** since joining the protocol.



85% of those surveyed believe the GLAA has been **effective in influencing** businesses to **identify and prevent exploitation** in their supply chains.



Payment was the **top labour exploitation issue** found in supply chains over the last 12 months
