Modern Slavery In The 'S' Of ESG

Addressing modern slavery firmly sits in 'S' of ESG (environment, social and governance) agenda; it is a part of how we are responsible towards people and communities, alongside the environment and governance.

At present, we see crucial developments in protecting and enhancing the environment, so we want to raise awareness of the plight of modern slavery victims and how addressing it and demonstrating your impact can contribute to well-rounded ESG impact for your organisation.

Why We Should All Care

We often think of slavery as a crime of the past, but it is a complex, ever-evolving issue affecting 136,000 people in the UK alone and around 40.3 million people globally. Today, conflict and crisis, like we see in Ukraine and Syria, create modern slavery risks in workforces. As we as a society make critical traction towards an eco-sustainable future, we need to ensure we consider that the renewable goods we buy are not made by people trapped in forced labour.
